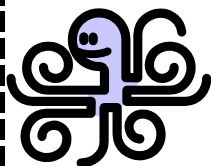
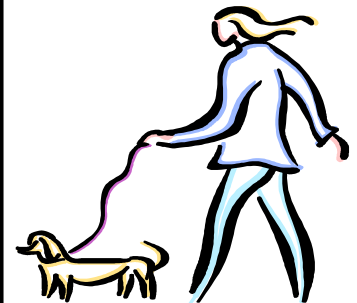

#### Northumberland County Council -extract from Press Release 26.01.11.—Take your voice with you when you move.

Preparations are currently on track for a UK wide referendum to change the voting system for electing mp's in the UK parliament. Although at the time of writing the date is not yet confirmed, the UK government is proposing to hold a **referendum on May 5th**. **If you live in Northumberland and want to cast a vote on the day, you must be on the County Electoral Register.** Between mid-August and November each year annual registration forms are delivered to every house and the results are used to compile the electoral register. If you moved after this time then you may have to update your registration.
