

## JOINT MEETINGS WITH TOWN / PARISH COUNCILS

### STREET LIGHTING COSTS FOR ADDITIONAL ITEMS

#### Costs for Additional Items

1. New Residential Type Lighting Column – the average cost for each new lighting column will be £900 (an 8% discount), subject to location, connection and commissioning, and a supply of electricity being within 5m of the proposed column location. Generally, any requests for additional lighting columns will be delivered in line with the main replacement programme.
2. New Lighting Unit on Electricity Company Network Pole – the average cost for fitting a lighting unit to a network pole is £750. This is subject to approval by the electricity supply company and space exists on the pole for fitting the lighting unit.
3. Conservation or Decorative Lighting Column – each request would have to be dealt with on a one for one basis, as these are not included within the Modernisation Project. As a guide a 5m embellished column fitted with a Victorian lantern will cost in the region of £2,000.
4. Street Level Wi-Fi project – a street lighting column can be enabled for Street Level Wi-Fi at an approximate cost of £800. However, this is subject to survey and a connection from an NCC building or network being available.
5. Christmas Lighting – requests for new infrastructure will be considered as long as the column is structurally sound, and generally speaking a supply point on a lighting column to allow the connection of a Christmas decoration can be fitted for £350.
6. Column Painting – the project is installing galvanised columns, but will consider column painting in areas that the Town and Parish Council feel would benefit the area. In general it costs around £50 to paint a column.
7. Removing Lighting – we do not plan to remove any lighting, but will consider requests. Please note we will have to carry out a consultation exercise with all parties affected. If we get one objection we cannot remove the light. As a guide the cost to remove a single lighting column will be in the region of £500.
